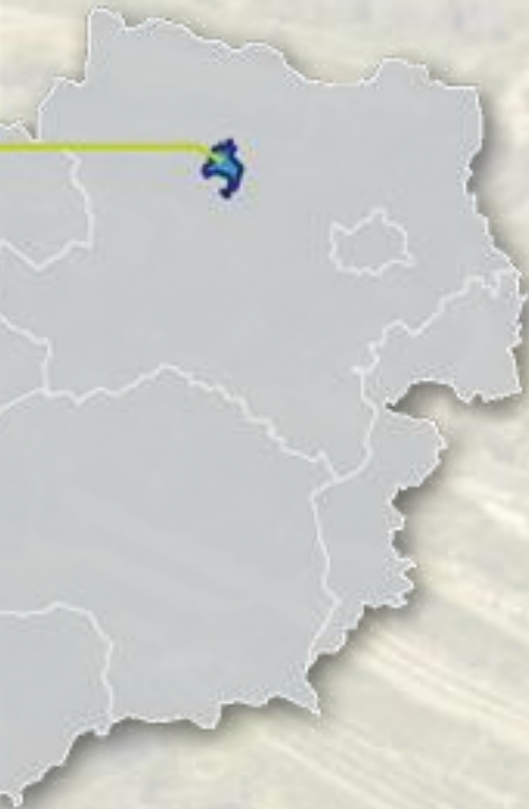

Quality Categories in the Wachau



Steinfeder

Light and airy. Wines labeled “Steinfeder” offer a fresh, pure drinking experience with an alcohol content of up to 11.5% ABV. Their name comes from the Steinfeder grass, which grows on the rocky, steep terraces of the Wachau. It is as light as a feather—just like the wines themselves.



Rich in nuance and full of character. Federspiel wines showcase every facet of their unique terroir. Striking a perfect balance between elegance and depth, they are versatile and, with an alcohol content of up to 12.5% ABV, make ideal companions for meals. The name traces back to falconry: the “Federspiel” was used to lure the falcons back.



Complex and long-lasting. The grapes for Smaragd wines remain on the vine longer. They thus form the basis for particularly complex, structured, and full-bodied wines with no oak influence, starting at 12.5% ABV. Their aging potential is promising. The dry stone walls that characterize the Wachau landscape are the habitat of their namesake, the magnificent emerald lizard.

The Burgundy Varieties

Burgundy grape varieties, including Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, exhibit remarkable diversity and quality, shaped by the region's unique terroir. With their finesse, complexity, and a balanced interplay of fruitiness and acidity, they offer discerning wine lovers an unparalleled tasting experience.

Residual Sugar

In Austria, the residual sugar content in wine is measured and expressed in grams per liter (g/l). This value indicates how much sugar remains in the wine after fermentation. A low residual sugar content usually indicates a dry wine, while a higher content suggests a semi-dry, semi-sweet, or sweet wine. The Austrian wine industry has clear guidelines for classifying wines based on their residual sugar content.

Stating the residual sugar content on the label allows consumers to select the wine they prefer based on their personal taste.

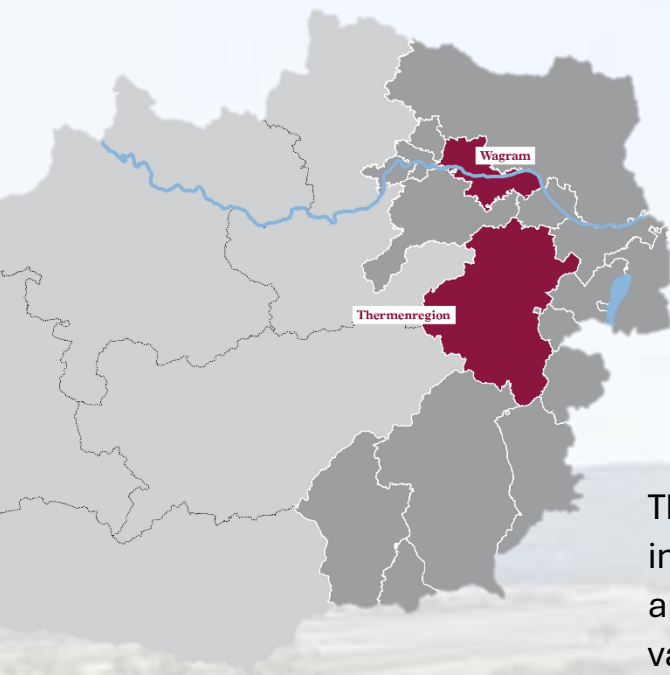

Thermenregion DAC



The Thermenregion is a major wine-growing region in Lower Austria, known for its unique Rotgipfler and Zierfandler wines. These indigenous grape varieties are characteristic of the region and reflect the terroir and the traditional craftsmanship of the local winemakers.

Rotgipfler is an aromatic white wine variety with notes of exotic fruits and flowers, while Zierfandler features lively acidity and complex aromas reminiscent of citrus fruits and spices.

In addition to Rotgipfler and Zierfandler, the “Thermenregion DAC” also includes other grape varieties such as: Pinot Blanc, Pinot Gris, Chardonnay, Neuburger, Pinot Noir, St. Laurent, Blauer Portugieser, and Zweigelt. These varieties often produce elegant, well-structured wines that can be enjoyed both young and aged.

Wine Categories in Austria



The quality levels of Austrian wine are defined by a system of designations. The basic quality level is wine without a specific indication of origin; the wine comes from Austria.

In addition, there are regional wines (local wines) that refer to a specific region or locality, known as “Landweine.”

The “DAC” (Districtus Austriae Controllatus) quality level designates wines from specific regions with defined quality standards.

Kabinett wine is now rarely produced; this wine must be dry and may not exceed 13% ABV.

At the top of the hierarchy are the Prädikat wines, which are divided into various categories such as Spätlese, Auslese, Beerenauslese, Trockenbeerenauslese, Eiswein, Strohwein, and Schilfwein, based on sugar content.

Austrian Zweigelt is a popular red wine variety known for its deep ruby color, juicy fruit flavors of cherries and berries, and a velvety texture.

Interior-design styles



Tonamphore

The world of wine offers a wide variety of aging styles that significantly influence a wine's character. Generally, a distinction is made between aging in stainless steel tanks and aging in oak barrels, with stainless steel tanks emphasizing freshness and oak barrels imparting complex aromas. Young, fruit-forward wines are often aged in stainless steel tanks to preserve their primary aromas. Aging in small oak barrels, known as barriques, imparts notes of vanilla, caramel, and toasted aromas to the wine. Wines aged in amphorae or concrete tanks are characterized by a distinctive minerality and structure. Natural wines are usually left unfiltered and aged without additives, giving them a rustic and authentic character. The duration of aging also plays a role: while white wines are often enjoyed young, many red wines benefit from a longer aging period. Sweet wines are often concentrated through late harvesting, noble rot, or the drying of the grapes. Sparkling wines such as Champagne also mature on the lees, which gives them a fine perlage and complex aromas. Overall, it is clear that the style of aging is a decisive factor in the quality and taste of a wine.

St. Laurent & Merlot

St. Laurent is an aromatic red wine variety known for its soft tannins and notes of cherry, berries, and spices.

Merlot is a fruit-forward grape variety with a medium body, soft tannins, and aromas of plums and chocolate.

Red and White Wine Production



The production of red wine and white wine differs primarily in the way the grapes are processed. In red wine production, the grapes are fermented together with their skins (maceration), which gives the wine its characteristic color, tannins, and aromas.

In contrast, grapes for white wine are typically pressed immediately to separate the juice from the skins, resulting in a clear, light-colored wine.

During fermentation, red wine is often fermented at warmer temperatures to ensure optimal extraction of color and tannins from the skins, while white wine is typically fermented at cooler temperatures to preserve the wine's freshness and fruitiness. After fermentation, red wine is often left on the skins to extract further aromas.

Finally, red wines are often aged for a longer period to enhance their structure and complexity, while white wines are typically consumed young to preserve their freshness.

The red Cuvées

These blends may be made from traditional grape varieties such as Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, and Syrah, or from lesser-known local varieties, resulting in a wide range of flavors and textures. Red wine blends offer an exciting way to explore the complexity and diversity of the world of wine.

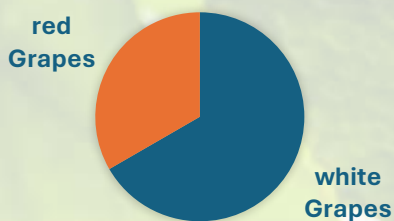

GRAPE VARIETIES IN AUSTRIA



Austrian quality grape varieties represent a wide range of indigenous and international varieties that reflect the country's unique terroirs. Grüner Veltliner, Austria's flagship variety, is distinguished by its freshness and versatility, while Zweigelt, a cross between Blaufränkisch and St. Laurent, is known for its velvety texture and fruity aromas. Other outstanding grape varieties include Blaufränkisch, Riesling, St. Laurent, Rotgipfler, and Welschriesling, each offering its own distinctive characteristics and styles.

In Austria, 28 white and 14 red grape varieties are approved for the production of quality wine.

Difference between a blended wine (gemischter Satz) and a cuvée



Blended Wine
(Gemischter Satz)

A cuvée is a wine made from a blend of grape varieties, which are often vinified separately and then blended together to achieve the desired style and flavor.

In contrast, the term “Gemischter Satz” refers specifically to vineyards where different grape varieties are grown, harvested, and processed together.

While in a cuvée the grape varieties may be vinified separately, in a Gemischter Satz the grapes are processed and fermented together, giving the wine a unique expression of the terroir.

Both concepts emphasize the diversity and complexity of wines, but differ in their production methods and their focus on grape blends.
